Only two months after one of the most catastrophic storms in American history, the sense of urgency that followed Hurricane Harvey has already begun slipping away in some levels of government. But before the rest of the nation and Texas move on entirely, Harris County Judge Emmett will unveil 15 specific recommendations that federal, state and local governments – as well as those in the private sector – need to consider to help Harris County and southeast Texas alleviate the threat of a similar disaster in the future. Judge Emmett will meet with members of the news media to unveil and discuss these proposals.
