Take-Back Day Details

The Harris County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Facility will again be in partnership with the Drug Enforcement Administration Office of Diversion Control by collecting unused or expired medications on the National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day April 30th from 10 AM – 2 PM.

The facility will be open to the public for HHW collections from 9 AM – 2 PM but will only accept pharmaceutical items from 10 AM – 2 PM.

The DEA will accept medications only – they will not collect items with needles.
